PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable John Adrian Louis, Earl of Hopetoun, Viscount Aithrie, and Baron Hope, in the Peerage of Scotland; Baron Hopetoun of Hopetoun, and Baron Niddry of Niddry Castle, in the Peerage of the United Kingdom; Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George; Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the *Public Service Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1133, Part VI., section 135) and in the *Banks and Currency Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1164, Part III., section 20), I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint

WEDNESDAY, THE 21ST, THURSDAY, THE 22ND, AND FRIDAY, THE 23RD* DAYS OF OCTOBER INSTANT, to be observed as Public Half-Holidays, from the hour of 12 o'clock noon on each day, at Warrnambool;

THURSDAY, THE 22ND DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT, to be observed as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Bannockburn and Bellarine, and at Geelong, and as a Bank Holiday at Drysdale and Portarlington;

WEDNESDAY, THE 28TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT, to be observed as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Goulburn;

TUESDAY, THE 3RD DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT, to be observed as a Public Holiday and a Bank Holiday throughout Victoria;

MONDAY, THE 9TH DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT, to be observed as a Bank Holiday throughout Victoria;

WEDNESDAY, THE 11TH DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT, to be observed as a Public Holiday throughout the Boroughs of Daylesford and Heathcote and the Shires of Hampden and McIver, and as a Bank Holiday at Daylesford;

THURSDAY, THE 12TH DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT, to be observed as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Whittlesea, and as a Bank Holiday at Omco;

WEDNESDAY, THE 18TH DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT, to be observed as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Dundas;

FRIDAY, THE 20TH DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT, to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Clunes;

FRIDAY, THE 27TH DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT, to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Newlyn.
