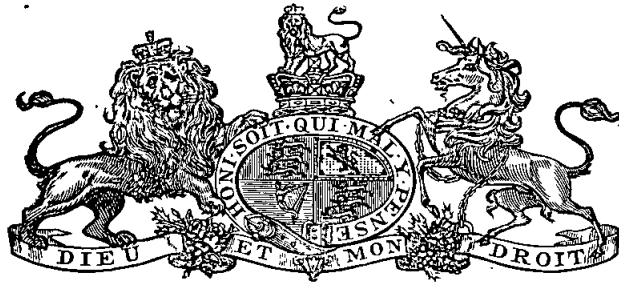

PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable John Adrian Louis, Earl of Hopetoun, Viscount Aithrie, and Baron Hope, in the Peerage of Scotland; Baron Hopetoun of Hopetoun, and Baron Niddry of Niddry Castle, in the Peerage of the United Kingdom; Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George; Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the *Public Service Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1133, Part VI., section 135) and in the *Banks and Currency Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1164, Part III., section 20), I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint

WEDNESDAY, THE 25TH DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT,

to be observed as a Public Holiday at Echuca and within the Shire of Metcalfe, and as a Bank Holiday at Stawell;

FRIDAY, THE 27TH DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT,

to be observed as a Public Half-Holiday (from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon) within the Borough of Portland, and as a Bank Holiday at Sheep Hills and Warracknabeal;

WEDNESDAY, THE 4TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT,

to be observed as a Public Holiday at Richmond and within the Shire of Maldon, and as a Bank Holiday at Avenel;

SATURDAY, THE 7TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT,

to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Berwick;

TUESDAY, THE 10TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT,

to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Mooroopna and Shepparton;

WEDNESDAY, THE 11TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT,

to be observed as a Public Holiday within the Borough of Majorca and the Shire of Swan Hill,\* and as a Bank Holiday at Kerang;

THURSDAY, THE 12TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT,

to be observed as a Public Holiday within the Shires of Gisborne and Lancefield and within the North-Western and South-Western Ridings of the Shire of Lillydale, and as a Bank Holiday at Loch;

FRIDAY, THE 13TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT,

to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Learmonth;

TUESDAY, THE 17TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT,

to be observed as a Public Holiday within the Shires of Benalla, Bacchus Marsh, Bairnsdale, and Kilmore, and as a Bank Holiday at Bairnsdale, Charlton, Kilmore, Kyneton, Mansfield, and Telford;

THURSDAY, THE 19TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT,

to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Heidelberg.
