### PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

### PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable John Adrian Louis, Earl of Hopetoun, Viscount Aithrie, and Baron Hope, in the Peerage of Scotland; Baron Hopetoun of Hopetoun, and Baron Niddry of Niddry Castle, in the Peerage of the United Kingdom; Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George; Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the Public Service Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1133, Part VI., section 135) and in the Banks and Currency Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1164, Part III., section 20), I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays or Bank Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, viz.:—

WEDNESDAY, THE 6TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Echuca;

FRIDAY, THE 8TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the East and South Ridings of the Shire of Borung, and as a Bank Holiday at Tungamah;

Wednesday, the 13th day of September instant,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Borung and the North and North-East Ridings of the Shire of Wimmera, and as a Bank Holiday at Kerang, Sheep Hills, and Warracknabeal;

THURSDAY, THE 14TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Portland and the Shires of Mount Rouse and Portland;

FRIDAY, THE 22ND DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Echuca and the Shire of Benalla, and as a Bank Holiday throughout the Shire of Bright; WEDNESDAY, THE 27TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Devenish Riding of the Shire of Benalla, and as a Bank Holiday at Dookie;

THURSDAY, THE 28TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Wimmera, and as a Bank Holiday at Horsham and Nathalia;

THURSDAY, THE 5TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT,

as a Bank Holiday at Nathalia;

WEDNESDAY, THE 25TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT,

as a Bank Holiday at Mooroopna.
