PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable John Adrian Louis, Earl of Hopetoun, Viscount Aithrie, and Baron Hope, in the Peerage of Scotland; Baron Hopetoun of Hopetoun, and Baron Niddry of Niddry Castle, in the Peerage of the United Kingdom; Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George; Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the Public Service Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1133, Part VI., section 135) and in the Banks and Currency Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1164, Part III., section 20), I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays or Bank Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, viz.:—

TUESDAY, THE 24TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of $\,$ Dunmunkle ;

Wednesday, the 25th day of October instant, as a Public Holiday throughout the South-Western and Southern Ridings of the Shire of Tungamah;

THURSDAY, THE 26TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Bellaring as a Public Holiday and Bank Holiday at Geelong, and as a Bank Holiday at Portarlington;

FRIDAY, THE 27TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT,
as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Goulburn and at Avenel, and as a Public Holiday and Bank Holiday at Seymour;

TUESDAY, THE 31ST DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Port Fairy, and as a Bank Holiday at Newstead;

THURSDAY, THE 2ND DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Colac, and as a Bank Holiday at Beeac;

TUESDAY, THE 7TH DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT,

as a Public Holiday throughout Victoria;*

WEDNESDAY, THE 15TH DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of McIvor.
