PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable John Adrian Louis, Earl of Hopetoun, Viscount Aithrie, and Baron Hope, in the Peerage of Scotland; Baron Hopetoun of Hopetoun, and Baron Niddry of Niddry Castle, in the Peerage of the United Kingdom; Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George; Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c., &c.

In pursuance of the provisions contained in the Public Service Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1133, Part VI., section 135) and in the Banks and Currency Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1164, Part III., section 20), I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays or Bank Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, viz.:—

TUESDAY, THE 31ST DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Belfast, and as a Bank Holiday at Port Fairy;

TUESDAY, THE 7TH, AND THURSDAY, THE 9TH DAYS OF NOVEMBER NEXT,

as Bank Holidays throughout Victoria;

WEDNESDAY, THE 15TH, THURSDAY, THE 16TH, AND FRIDAY, THE 17TH DAYS OF NOVEMBER NEXT, as Public Half-Holidays, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon on each day, throughout the Town of Warrnambool;*

WEDNESDAY, THE 15TH DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT,

as a Bank Holiday at Nagambie;

THURSDAY, THE 16TH DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Warrnambool; FRIDAY, THE 17TH DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Creswick, and as a Bank Holiday at Allendale, Clunes, and Smeaton;

THURSDAY, THE 23RD DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Broadford and Pyalong;

FRIDAY, THE 24TH DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday at Ballarat.
