PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Honorable John Madden, LL.D., the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the Colony of Victoria, and Administrator of the Government of the said Colony, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the Banks and Currency Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1164, Part III., section 20), I, the Administrator of the Government of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this Proclamation revoke in part the Proclamation bearing date the 23rd day of January, 1893, so far only as the same relates to the appointment of Thursday, the 2nd day of March, 1893, to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Tallangatta; and in pursuance of: the provisions contained in the said Act and in the Public Service Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1133, Part VI., section 135), I do hereby appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays or Bank Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified,

WEDNESDAY, THE 22ND DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT,

to be observed as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Mount Franklin, Newstead, and Rutherglen;

THURSDAY, THE 23RD DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT,

to be observed as a Bank Holiday throughout the Shire of Maffra;

MONDAY, THE 27TH DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT,

to be observed as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Lancefield and Romsey, and as a Bank Holiday at Lancefield;

MONDAY, THE 27TH DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT, and THURSDAY, THE 16TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT,

to be observed as Bank Holidays throughout the Shire of Romsey;

WEDNESDAY, THE 1ST DAY OF MARCH NEXT,

to be observed as a Public Holiday throughout the Boroughs of St. Arnaud* and Stawell and the Shire of Stawell, and as a Bank Holiday at Richmond; THURSDAY, THE 2ND DAY OF MARCH NEXT,

to be observed as a Bank Holiday throughout the Shire of Rosedale and at Orbost;

FRIDAY, THE 3RD DAY OF MARCH NEXT,

to be observed as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Bellarine * and Lawloit *, and as a Bank Holiday at Kaniva and Learmonth;

Tuesday, the 7th day of March next, and Thursday, the 9th day of March next, to be observed as Bank Holidays at Cobram, Strathmerton, and Yarroweyah;

WEDNESDAY, THE 8TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT,

to be observed as a Public Holiday throughout the North Riding of the Shire of Euroa; as a Public Holiday and Bank Holiday at Geelong, and as a Bank Holiday at Mooroopna and Shepparton;

FRIDAY, THE 10TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT,

to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Beechworth;

SATURDAY, THE 11TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT,

to be observed as a Bank Holiday throughout the Shire of Bright;

WEDNESDAY, THE 15TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT,

to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Echuca;

THURSDAY, THE 16TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT,

to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Bairnsdale and Bruthen;
