PUBLIC HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Honorable John Madden, LL.D., the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the Colony of Victoria, and Administrator of the Government of the said Colony, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the Public Service Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1133, Part VI., section 135), I, the Administrator of the Government of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates named hereunder to be observed as Public Holidays at the respective places specified, that is to say:—

FRIDAY, THE 17TH DAY OF MARCH INSTANT,

throughout the Borough of Koroit;

MONDAY, THE 20TH DAY OF MARCH INSTANT,

throughout the Shire of Alberton.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Colony, at Melbourne, this fifteenth day of March, in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and ninety-three, and in the fifty-sixth year of Her Majesty's reign.
