SHIRE OF MORNINGTON RE-DEFINED.

WHEREAS by the Local Government Acts it is amongst other things enacted that, subject to the provisions of the said Acts, the Governor in Council may from time to time make Orders, amongst other things, to constitute any part of Victoria containing rateable property capable of yielding upon a rate not exceeding One shilling in the pound on the annual value thereof, estimated under the provisions of the said Acts, a sum of Five hundred pounds a shire; to subdivide or re-subdivide any municipal district into any number of subdivisions not exceeding eight; to alter the boundaries of or abolish the subdivisions existing in any municipal district; to determine and alter within the limits prescribed by the said Acts the number of councillors assigned to any municipality; and to alter and adjust the boundaries of continuous municipal districts, and determine any questions arising out of such alteration and adjustment: and that every such Order shall be published in the *Government Gazette*, and shall take effect as from the day of such publication: And whereas a petition has been presented to the Governor in Council in accordance with the provisions of the said Acts, signed by a majority of the ratepayers of the West Riding of the Shire of Mornington, praying that the West Riding of the said shire be severed from the said shire and constituted a separate municipality under the name and title of the Shire of New Mornington: And whereas the substance and prayer of such petition have been published in the manner directed by the said Acts: Now therefore His Excellency the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the

Executive Council thereof, doth hereby make an Order constituting a shire to be named the Shire of New Mornington, the boundaries of which, as also those of the said Shire of Mornington as reduced, shall be those hereunder set forth and described; and doth hereby further order that the Council of the said newly-constituted Shire of New Mornington shall consist of nine members, and that the said new Shire shall not be subdivided at present:—

NEW MORNINGTON SHIRE CONSTITUTED AND DEFINED.

Commencing on the eastern shore of Port Phillip Bay where the south boundary of the parish of Moorooduc abuts thereon; thence northerly by the shore of said bay to the south-west angle of the parish of Frankston; thence south-easterly and southerly by the boundary of that parish to the north-west angle of allotment 1, parish of Moorooduc; thence east by the north boundary of said allotment to its north-east angle; thence south by the road forming the east boundary of allotments 1, 2, 3, and 4 and the west boundary of the parish of Bittern to the south-east angle of the parish of Moorooduc; and thence westerly by the south boundary of the parish last named to the point of commencement.

Wherever the line so described as aforesaid runs beside or along a river, creek, or road, whether such is specifically mentioned or not, the centre of such river, creek, or road shall be taken to be the boundary line.

MORNINGTON SHIRE REDUCED AND RE-DEFINED.

Commencing on the eastern shore of Port Phillip Bay where the south boundary of the parish of Frankston abuts thereon; thence south-easterly by the boundary of that parish to the centre of the road between allotments 1 and 19, parish of Moorooduc, at the north-west angle of allotment 1; thence east by the north boundary of said allotment to its north-east angle, and thence south by the road forming the east boundary of allotments 1, 2, 3, and 4, and the west boundary of the parish of Bittern to the south-west angle of allotment 55b, in the last-named parish; thence easterly by the south boundaries of allotments 55a, 53a, 50n, 49n, 46a, 45b, 42a, and 41a to the west boundary of the parish of Tyabb; thence southerly and easterly by the west and south boundaries of that parish to the shore of Western Port Bay; thence northerly by the shore of that bay to the north boundary of the last-named parish; thence westerly and northerly by the south and west boundaries of the parish of Langwarrin to the south-east angle of allotment 54, parish of Lyndhurst; thence west and north by that allotment and west and north by the Banyan Water-holes pre-emptive section and allotment 95 to the road forming the south boundary of allotments 97b, 92, and 91; thence westerly by that road to the Melbourne and Frankston road; thence southerly by that road to the south-east angle of allotment 1a; thence south-westerly by that allotment and a line to the shore of Port Phillip Bay aforesaid; and thence southerly by the shore of that bay to the commencing point.

PART OF THE SHIRE OF WOORAYL SEVERED THEREFROM AND ANNEXED TO THE SHIRE OF POOWONG AND JEETHO.

WHEREAS by the Local Government Acts it is amongst other things enacted that, subject to the provisions of the said Acts, the Governor in Council may from time to time make Orders, amongst other things, to sever any portion of Victoria forming part of a municipal district from such municipal district, and annex the same to any other municipal district with which the portion so severed forms one continuous area, and from time to time make any apportionment of property rights and liabilities, and give any directions as to any matters and things that may be necessary to do justice as between the municipalities concerned; and that every such Order shall be published in the *Government Gazette*, and shall take effect as from the day of such publication: And whereas the powers conferred upon the Governor by the said Acts are now exercised upon a petition, signed by a majority of the ratepayers of a portion of the West Riding of the Shire of Woorayl, with regard to a certain area therein described, notices of such petition having been published in the manner prescribed in the said Acts: Now therefore His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in compliance with the prayer of the petition hereinbefore mentioned, doth by this present Order sever from the Shire of Woorayl the portion described in such petition, and doth annex the portion so severed from such shire to the Shire of Poowong and Jeetho, and, with the advice aforesaid, doth re-define the boundaries of the said Shire of Woorayl as hereby reduced and of the West Riding thereof, and of the said Shire of Poowong and Jeetho as hereby enlarged, in the manner set forth hereunder, that is to say:—

WOORAYL SHIRE REDUCED AND RE-DEFINED.

Commencing at a point on the road known as McDonald's Track, where the north boundary of allotment 11, parish of Korumburra, abuts thereon; thence east, south, and easterly by the southern boundary of the parish of Allambie to the east angle of block 95; thence south-easterly by a road to the south angle of block 120a, parish of Allambie East; thence north-easterly by a road and the north-west boundaries of blocks 122a and 122b to the north angle of the last-mentioned block; thence south-easterly by a road to the south angle of allotment 113; thence north-easterly by a road to the east angle of allotment 87; thence north-westerly by a road to the south angle of allotment 88; thence north-easterly by the south-east boundary of that allotment and the south-east boundary of allotment 90, and north-westerly by part of the north-east boundary of the last-mentioned allotment to the south angle of allotment 91; thence north-easterly by the south-east boundary of that allotment and the south-east boundaries of allotments 92 and 93, and easterly by the south boundary of allotment 95 to the south-east angle of the last-mentioned allotment; thence south and east by the west and south boundaries of allotment 96 to the south-east angle thereof; thence south by a road to the south-west angle of allotment 31, parish of Narracan South; thence east by the south boundary of the last-named parish to the west boundary of the township of Darlimurla; thence south by that boundary to the north side of the Mirboo Railway; thence easterly by that railway to its intersection with the north-west boundary of M. Rout's selection, parish of Mirboo; thence south-westerly by that selection, and southerly by that selection and the west boundary of allotments 5, 6, 7, 14, 15, and a line to the north-west angle of allotment 52; thence south by the west boundary of allotments 52 and 53 to the south-west angle of the last-mentioned allotment; thence east by a road being the north boundary of allotments 68, 67, 66, 65, 61, 63, and 62 to the Morwell River; thence southerly by said river to the north-west corner of allotment 1, parish of Gunyah Gunyah; thence east along the north boundary of said allotment to its north-east angle; thence south by the east boundary of allotments 1, 2, 3, 4, 13a, and 13 to the south-east angle of the last-named allotment; thence south-westerly by the road from Foster to Rosedale to Mount Fatigue; thence west by a direct line to the north-east angle of allotment 61b, parish of Mirboo South; thence west by the north boundary of allotment 61b and 61a to the south angle of allotment 37, parish of Dumbalk; thence north-westerly by a road to the north-west angle of said allotment; thence west by a road being the north boundary of allotments 37a, 36, 35, 31, 102b, 102a, 101, 100, and 99 to the north-west angle of the last-named allotment; thence south-westerly by a road being the north-western boundary of allotment 99 to the road forming the south-west boundary of block 89a; thence southerly by the eastern boundaries of the parishes of Nerrena, Meenyan, and Tarwin South to the northern boundary of the parish of Waratah; thence easterly by that boundary to the sea coast; thence southerly, westerly, and north-westerly by the sea coast to the east boundary of the parish of Wonthaggi; thence northerly by that boundary to the south-west angle of block 21, parish of Kirrak; thence easterly by a road to the south-east angle of allotment 13; thence northerly by a road to the south-west angle of allotment 12; thence easterly by that allotment and allotment 9, and northerly by the latter allotment and a road to the north-west angle of block 51; thence westerly by the road from Anderson's Inlet to the south-west angle of block 50; thence northerly by a road to the north-west angle of block 44a; thence easterly by a road to the north-west

angle of block 47; thence northerly by a road to the north-west angle of block 41; thence easterly and northerly by the south and east boundary of the parish of Kongwak to the north-west angle of allotment 51a, parish of Leongatha; thence east by a road to the north-east angle of allotment 51b; thence north by a road to the north-west angle of allotment 52a; thence east by a road to the south-west angle of allotment 72b, parish of Korumburra; thence northerly by a road and the west boundary of allotments 68c, 68b, 68a, 52c, 52b, 52a, 51b, and 51a to the Great Southern Railway; thence westerly by the centre of said railway to the western boundary of allotment 32; thence northerly by the western boundary of allotments 32, 37, and 41 to the north-west angle of the allotment last named; thence east by the north boundary of said allotment to the south-west angle of allotment 42; thence north by a road to the north-west angle of said allotment; thence west by a road to the south-west angle of allotment 43; thence north by a road to the north-west angle of allotment 44; thence east by the north boundary of the allotment last named to its north-east angle; thence north by a road to the north-west angle of allotment 46; thence east by a road to the south-east angle of allotment 11; thence north by the east boundary and west by the north boundary of said allotment to the commencing point.

WEST RIDING REDUCED AND RE-DEFINED.

Commencing on the northern boundary of the north-east angle of allotment 100, in the parish of Allambie East; thence south-easterly by the eastern boundary of said allotment to the Tarwin River; thence south-westerly by said river to the north-west angle of allotment 102, parish of Mardan; thence south-easterly by the western boundary of said allotment to its south-west angle; thence easterly by a road to the north-east angle of allotment 22; thence south by a road to the south-east angle of said allotment; thence east by a road to the north-east angle of allotment 38; thence south by a road to the south-east angle of allotment 48; thence west by a road to the north-east angle of allotment 106; thence south by a road to the south-west angle of allotment 108a; thence east by a road to the north-east angle of allotment 123; thence south by the east boundary of said allotment to its south-east angle; thence east by a road to the north-east angle of allotment B2; thence south by the east boundaries of allotments B2, 117A, 117B, and 117C to the south-east angle of allotment last named; thence south-westerly by a road to the southern angle of allotment A1, parish of Neerim; thence north-westerly to the northern angle of allotment A2; thence south-westerly to the south-west angle of allotment 15B; thence north by a road to the south-east angle of allotment 14b; thence west by the south boundaries of allotments 14b, 14a, 13b, and 13a to the south-west angle of the allotment last named; thence north by a road to the north-east angle of allotment 12c; thence west by the north boundaries of allotments 12c, 12b, 12a, 12p, and 12a to the north-west angle of the allotment last named; thence south by a road to the south-west angle of said allotment; thence west by the south boundary of allotment 10a to its south-west angle; thence west by a road to the south-west angle of allotment 60c, parish of Leongatha; thence north-easterly by a road to the north-east angle of allotment 56a; thence westerly by a road to the shire boundary at the south-west angle of allotment 72b, parish of Korumburra; thence following the shire boundary northerly, westerly, northerly, and easterly to the point of commencement.

POOWONG AND JEETHO SHIRE ENLARGED AND RE-DEFINED.

Commencing at the south-west angle of allotment 89, parish of Lang Lang; thence easterly by the south boundaries of that parish and the parish of Lang Lang East to the Bass River; thence south-easterly and east by a road to the north-west angle of allotment 38, parish of Jeetho West; thence southerly by a road to the north-west angle of the parish of Jumbunna East; thence further southerly by the road forming the west boundary of that parish to the south-west angle thereof; thence easterly by the north boundary of the parish of Kongwak to the west boundary of allotment 2 in that parish; thence north and east by that allotment to the north-east angle thereof; thence south by a road to the north-west angle of block 30a; thence east by that block and a road to the south-east angle of block 36b; thence north by a road to the south-west angle of allotment 50n, parish of Leongatha; thence east by a road to the north-east angle of allotment 51b; thence north by a road to the north-west angle of allotment 52a; thence east by a road to the south-west angle of allotment 72b, parish of Korumburra; thence northerly by a road and the west boundary of allotments 68c, 68b, 68a, 52c, 52b, 52a, 51b, and 51a to the Great Southern Railway; thence westerly by the centre of said railway to the western boundary of allotment 32; thence northerly by the western boundary of allotments 32, 37, and 41 to the north-west angle of the allotment last named; thence east by the north boundary of said allotment to the south-west angle of allotment 42; thence north by a road to the north-west angle of said allotment; thence west by a road to the south-west angle of allotment 43; thence north by a road to the north-west angle of allotment 44; thence east by the north boundary of the allotment last named to its north-east angle; thence north by a road to the north-west angle of allotment 46; thence east by a road to the south-east angle of allotment 11; thence north by the east boundary and west by the north boundary of said allotment to the road known as McDonald's Track; thence north-easterly by the latter road to the north-east angle of allotment 46, parish of Poowong East; thence west by a road and the north boundary of allotment 45, and south by the west boundary of the last-mentioned allotment to the north-east angle of allotment 43; thence west, north, and west by a road to the south-west angle of allotment 39; thence north by a road to the north-east angle of allotment 30; thence west by a road to the north-west angle of the last-mentioned allotment; thence north by the road forming the west boundaries of allotments 29, 28, 27, and 26 to the Lang Lang River; thence north-westerly by that river to the north-east angle of allotment A², parish of Longwarry; thence

CASTLE DONNINGTON SHIRE CONSTITUTED AND DEFINED.

Commencing at the junction of Chalka Creek with the Murray River; thence westerly, southerly, and east by the northern boundaries of mallee blocks 13n and 13a, county of Karkarocoe, and the west and south boundaries of the last-mentioned block to the north-east angle of block 28a; thence south by blocks 28a and 28n to the south-east angle of the latter block; thence east and south-westerly by block 48a to the south-east angle thereof; thence east and south by blocks 59a and 55a to the south boundary of block 54a; thence easterly by that boundary and the south boundary of block 54n to Tyrrell Creek; thence northerly by that creek to the north boundary of block 52a, county of Tatchera; thence east by that block to the north-east angle thereof; thence north by the west boundary of block 35a to its north-west angle; thence east by the north boundary of blocks

35a, 34, 32, and 30 to the south-east corner of the parish of Kunat Kunat; thence north by the east boundary of said parish to the south-west angle of allotment 24; thence east by the south boundary of said allotment to the north-east angle of allotment 2, section 4, parish of Boga; thence north-westerly by a three-chain road to the south-west angle of allotment 5, section 3; thence east by the south boundary of said allotment to its south-east angle; thence south by the western boundary of allotment 13, section 1, parish of Benjeroop, to its south-west angle; thence easterly by a road being the south boundary of allotments 13, 16, and 17 to the south-east angle of the allotment last named; thence north by a road to the north-east angle of said allotment; thence east by the south boundary of allotment 19 to its south-east angle; thence north by the eastern boundary of said allotment to the River Loddon; thence north-westerly by said river to the Little Murray River; thence north-easterly by the river last named to the Murray River; thence following said river north-westerly and westerly to the point of commencement.

Commencing at the junction of Deep Creek with the Murray River; thence north-westerly by that river to the Little Murray River; thence south-westerly by that river to the Loddon River; thence south-easterly by that river to the eastern boundary of allotment 19, section 1, parish of Benjeroop; thence south by the east boundary and west by the south boundary of said allotment to its south-west angle; thence south by a road to the south-east angle of allotment 17; thence west and north-westerly by a road to the south-west angle of allotment 13; thence north by the western boundary of said allotment to the south-east angle of allotment 5, section 3, parish of Boga; thence west by the south boundary of said allotment to its south-west angle; thence south-easterly by a three-chain road to the north-east angle of allotment 2; thence south-westerly and westerly by the south boundary of allotment 24 to the eastern boundary of the parish of Kunat Kunat; thence south by the eastern boundary of said parish to the north boundary of mallee allotment 30; thence west by the north boundary of allotments 30, 32, 34, and 35a to the north-west angle of the allotment last named; thence south by the western boundary of said allotment to the north-west angle of allotment 35b; thence south-easterly by the northern boundary of said allotment to Lake Lalbert; thence southerly by the western margin of that lake and Lalbert Creek to the road to Ninneunook, at the north-east angle of allotment 17, section 4, parish of Towaninny; thence south-westerly by that road to the north-west angle of allotment 25a, section 1; thence east and south by that allotment to the north boundary of the Towaninny pre-emptive section; thence east by that section and allotment 22 to the north-east angle of the said allotment; thence southerly by a road to the south-west angle of allotment 17a; thence easterly by a road to the north-west angle of allotment 13; thence southerly by a road to the south-west angle of allotment 2; thence west by a road to the north-west angle of allotment 44, section 1, parish of Ninneunook; thence south by a road to the south-west angle of allotment 15; thence east by a road to the north-west angle of allotment 13; thence south, east, and south by a road to the south-west angle of allotment 9a; thence east by a road to the north-east angle of allotment 12, section B, parish of Bungulake, and further east by a line to the Avoca River; thence easterly and north-easterly by that river to the north boundary of the parish of Jeruk; thence easterly by that boundary to the west boundary of the parish of Marmal; thence north and easterly by the west and north boundaries of the parish of Marmal to the west boundary of the parish of Gredgwin; thence south and east by the west and south boundaries of that parish to the north-east angle of mallee allotment 149a, county of Tatchera; thence south by that allotment to the south-east angle thereof; thence east by the south boundaries of mallee allotments 149, 148, and 143, and northerly and westerly by the east and north boundaries of the last-mentioned allotment to the south-west angle of allotment 29, parish of Leaghur; thence north-easterly by a road to the south-west angle of allotment 28; thence northerly and easterly by that allotment to the south-east angle of mallee allotment 133; thence northerly by the east boundary of that allotment to the north-east angle thereof; thence east by the south boundary of mallee allotment 132, and north by the east boundaries of that allotment and mallee allotment 132a to the south boundary of mallee allotment 120; thence east by the south boundaries of that allotment and mallee allotment 120c and a road to the north-east angle of allotment 34, parish of Leaghur; thence easterly by a direct line and the road forming the north boundary of allotments 67a, 67, 2a, and 2n to the Loddon River; thence southerly by that river to the north boundary of the parish of Loddon; thence easterly by that boundary and the north boundary of the parish of Mincha West to Pyramid Creek; thence northerly by that creek to Box Creek; thence south-easterly by the latter creek to the Kow Swamp; thence easterly and southerly by the northern and eastern margins of that swamp to the north boundary of the parish of Patho; thence easterly by that boundary to the Swan Hill and Echuca road; thence south-easterly by that road to Taylor's Creek; thence north-easterly by that creek to the Gunbower Creek; thence northerly by the latter creek to Deep Creek; thence easterly by that creek to the commencing point.

Wherever the line so described as aforesaid runs beside or along any river, creek, or road, whether specifically mentioned or not, the centre of such river, creek, or road shall be taken to be the boundary line.
