PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable John Adrian Louis, Earl of Hopetoun, Viscount Aithrie, and Baron Hope, in the Peerage of Scotland; Baron Hopetoun of Hopetoun, and Baron Niddry of Niddry Castle, in the Peerage of the United Kingdom; Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George; Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the *Banks and Currency Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1164, Part III., section 20), I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this Proclamation revoke in part the Proclamation bearing date the 27th day of August, 1894, so far only as the same relates to the appointment of Friday, the 21st day of September, 1894, to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Wangaratta; and in pursuance of the provisions contained in the said Act and in the *Public Service Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1133, Part VI., section 135) I do hereby appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays or Bank Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, viz.:-

- WEDNESDAY, THE 12TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT,
as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Bet Bet;
- WEDNESDAY, THE 12TH, AND WEDNESDAY, THE 19TH, DAYS OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT, AND WEDNESDAY, THE 3RD DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT,
as Public Holidays throughout the Shire of St. Arnaud;
- WEDNESDAY, THE 19TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT,
as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Stawell;
- FRIDAY, THE 21ST DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT,
as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Echuca;
- TUESDAY, THE 25TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT,
as a Bank Holiday at Murtoa;

as Public Holidays throughout the Borough of Maryborough* and the Shire of Talbot*;
- WEDNESDAY, THE 26TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT, AND THURSDAY, THE 11TH, AND WEDNESDAY, THE 24TH DAYS OF OCTOBER NEXT,
as Public Holidays throughout the Devenish Riding of the Shire of Benalla;
- WEDNESDAY, THE 26TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT, AND THURSDAY, THE 18TH, AND WEDNESDAY, THE 24TH DAYS OF OCTOBER NEXT,
as Public Holidays throughout the Shire of Shepparton;
- FRIDAY, THE 28TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT,
as a Bank Holiday at Wycheproof;
- TUESDAY, THE 2ND, AND THURSDAY, THE 11TH DAYS OF OCTOBER NEXT,
as Public Holidays throughout the Shire of Tungamah;
- WEDNESDAY, THE 3RD DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT,
as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of St. Arnaud and the Shire of Borung; and as a Bank Holiday at Bridgewater-on-Loddon, Inglewood, and Maldon;
