DEATH OF HIS IMPERIAL MAJESTY THE CZAR OF RUSSIA.

INTELLIGENCE having been received of the death of His Imperial Majesty the Czar of Russia,
His Excellency the Governor in Council, with a desire to show due respect to the memory of
His Imperial Majesty, as well as to the family of the illustrious deceased, hereby directs:—

- 1. That the Officer in Command of the Naval Forces and the Military Commandant do cause the flags to be hoisted half-mast high until after the funeral.
- 2. That Flags on all Public Buildings be similarly hoisted.

It is requested that the Flags on board the Ships in the Harbor be also so displayed, and that similar marks of respect may, wherever possible, be accorded.
