PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable John Adrian Louis, Earl of Hopetoun, Viscount Aithrie, and Baron Hope, in the Peerage of Scotland; Baron Hopetoun of Hopetoun, and Baron Niddry of Niddry Castle, in the Peerage of the United Kingdom; Kinght Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George; Governor and Commander in Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the Public Service Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1133, Part VI., section 135) and in the Banks and Currency Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1164, Part III., section 20), I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays or Bank Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, viz.:—

WEDNESDAY, THE 14TH DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT,

as a Bank Holiday at Donald;

Thursday, the 15th day of February instant,

as a Bank Holiday at Tallangatta;

THURSDAY, THE 15TH, AND FRIDAY, THE 16TH, DAYS OF FEBRUARY INSTANT,

as Public Half-Holidays, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon on each day, throughout the Township of Tallangatta;*

FRIDAY, THE 16TH DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT,

as a Bank Holiday throughout the Borough of Creswick;

TUESDAY, THE 20TH DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Maldon and at Horsham, * and as a Bank Holiday at Castlemaine, Horsham, Maldon, and Newstead;

WEDNESDAY, THE 21ST DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT,

as a Public Holiday and Bank Holiday throughout the Borough of Rutherglen, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Alberton* and Rutherglen, and as a Bank Holiday throughout the City of Prahran, and at Alberton, Daylesford, Port Albert, and Yarram Yarram;

THUESDAY, THE 22ND DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT.

as a Bank Holiday throughout the Shire of Ballan and at Egerton;

Monday, the 26th day of February instant,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Lancefield, and as a Bank Holiday at Lancefield and Romsey;

WEDNESDAY, THE 28TH DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Rodney and Talbot, * and as a Bank Holiday at Shepparton, Talbot, and Tatura;

Wednesday, the 28th day of February Instant,* and Saturday, the 17th day of March next, as Public Holidays throughout the Borough of Majorca and the Shire of Avoca;

FRIDAY, THE 2ND DAY OF MARCH NEXT,

as a Bank Holiday at Smeaton;

THURSDAY, THE 1ST, AND THURSDAY, THE STH, DAYS OF MARCH NEXT, as Public Holidays throughout the North-west Riding of the Shire of Tungamah; *

SATURDAY, THE 3RD DAY OF MARCH NEXT,

as a Public Holiday and a Bank Holiday throughout the Shire of Bright;
