PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable Thomas, Baron Brassey, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath; Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the *Banks and Currency Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1164, Part III., section 20), I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do hereby revoke in part the Proclamation bearing date the 10th day of January, 1896, so far only as the same relates to the appointment of Wednesday, the 29th day of January, 1896, to be observed as a Bank Holiday at Rochester and Warragul; and in pursuance of the provisions contained in the said Act and in the *Public Service Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1133, Part VI., section 135), I do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays or Bank Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, viz. :—

WEDNESDAY, THE 29TH DAY OF JANUARY INSTANT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Ararat and the Shire of Warragul, and as a Bank Holiday at Dimboola;

MONDAY, THE 3RD DAY OF FEBRUARY NEXT,\* AND TUESDAY, THE 17TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT,

as Public Holidays throughout the Shire of Colac;

TUESDAY, THE 4TH DAY OF FEBRUARY NEXT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Town of Geelong, the Borough of Geelong West, and the Shire of South Barwon, and as a Bank Holiday at Geelong;

WEDNESDAY, THE 5TH DAY OF FEBRUARY NEXT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Marong,\* and as a Bank Holiday at Donald, Numurkah, Strathmerton, and Wunghnu;

WEDNESDAY, THE 5TH, AND THURSDAY, THE 6TH, DAYS OF FEBRUARY NEXT,

as Public Half-Holidays, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon on each day, throughout the Borough of Ararat\*;

THURSDAY, THE 6TH DAY OF FEBRUARY NEXT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Lancefield, and as a Bank Holiday at Ararat, Lancefield, and Romsey;

FRIDAY, THE 7TH DAY OF FEBRUARY NEXT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Tungamah\*;

WEDNESDAY, THE 12TH DAY OF FEBRUARY NEXT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Town of North Melbourne, the Borough of Stawell,\* and the Shire of Alberton,\* and as a Bank Holiday at Mooroopna;

WEDNESDAY, THE 19TH DAY OF FEBRUARY NEXT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Castlemaine and the Shire of Maldon, and as a Bank Holiday throughout the Borough of Rutherglen and at Castlemaine and Wangaratta;

WEDNESDAY, THE 26TH DAY OF FEBRUARY NEXT,  
as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Poowong and Jeetho;

THURSDAY, THE 27TH DAY OF FEBRUARY NEXT,  
as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Ballan, and as a Bank Holiday at Ballan;

WEDNESDAY, THE 11TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT,  
as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Swan Hill.\*
