PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable Thomas, Baron Brassey, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath;
Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the Public Scruice Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1133, Part VI., section 135), and in the
Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public
Holidays or Bank Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, viz.:—

Wednesday, the 26th day of Ferruary instant, as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Talbot* and the Mokean Riding of the Shire of Benalla, and as a Bank Holiday at Natimuk;

Thursday, the 27th day of Ferruary instant, and Thursday, the 26th day of March next,*

as Public Holidays throughout the Shire of Colac;

WEDNESDAY, THE 4TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Central, Tatong, and Warrenbayne Ridings of the Shire of Benalla, and the West Riding of the Shire of Dunmunkle, and as a Public Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, throughout the Town of Ballaarat East;

THURSDAY, THE 5TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT, as a Bank Holiday throughout the Shires of Maffra and Yarrawonga;

THURSDAY, THE 5TH* AND TUESDAY, THE 17TH, DAYS OF MARCH NEXT, as Public Holidays throughout the Shire of Yarrawonga;

FRIDAY, THE 6TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT, as a Bank Holiday at Alexandra;

MONDAY, THE 9TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Caulfield;

THURSDAY, THE 12TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT, as a Bank Holiday at Kingston;

FRIDAY, THE 13TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT, as a Bank Holiday at Beechworth;

FRIDAY, THE 13TH, AND TUESDAY, THE 17TH, DAYS OF MARCH NEXT, as Bank Holidays at Yackandandah;

TUESDAY, THE 17TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of St. Arnaud, and the Shires of Benalla and Bulla, and as a Bank Holiday at Charlton and Port Fairy;

TURSDAY, THE 17TH, AND WEDNESDAY, THE 18TH, DAYS OF MARCH NEXT, as Public Holidays throughout the Shire of Omeo*;

TUESDAY, THE 17TH, AND WEDNESDAY, THE 25TH, DAYS OF MARCH NEXT, as Bank Holidays at Tatura.
