#### PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

### PROCLAMATION

. By His Excellency the Right Honorable Thomas, Baron Brassey, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath; Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in the Public Service Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1133, Part VI., section 135) and in the Banks and Currency Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1164, Part III., section 20), I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and darks hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays or Bank Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, viz.:—

WEDNESDAY, THE 15TH DAY OF JANUARY INSTANT,

- as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Poowong and Jeetho\*, and as a Bank Holiday at Mildura;
- as a Bank Holiday at Nhill;

Wennesday, the 22nd day of January instant, Thursday, the 23rd day of January instant,

- as a Bank Holiday throughout the Shire of Moorabbin and at Bruthen;
  - Monday, the 27th day of January instant,
- as a Public Holiday throughout Victoria;

Wednesday, the 29th day of January instant,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Tarnagulla and the Shires of Bet Bet and Dunmunkle, and as a Bank Holiday at Deokie, Rochester, Tarnagulla, and Warragul;

WEDNESDAY, THE 26TH DAY OF FEBRUARY NEXT,

as a Public Holiday throughout the Town of Port Melbourne.
