BANK HALF-HOLIDAY.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable Thomas, Baron Brassey, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath;
Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in Part III. of the Banks and Currency Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1164), and in the Public and Bank Holidays Act 1887 (61 Vict. No. 1534), I, the Governor of Victoria, do by this my Proclamation appoint

THURSDAY, THE 14TH DAY OF DECEMBER INSTANT, a special day to be observed as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Nhill.
