WHEREAS by The Constitution Act it was amongst other things enacted that it should be lawful for the Governor to fix such places within Victoria, and, subject to the limitation therein contained, such times for holding the first and every other places within Victoria, and, subject to the limitation therein contained, such times for holding the first and every other session of the Council and Assembly, and to vary and alter the same respectively in such manner as he might think fit; and also from time to time to prorogue the said Council and Assembly, and to dissolve the said Assembly, by Proclamation or otherwise, from time to time to prorogue the said Council and Assembly, called "The Parliament of Victoria, whenever he should deem it expecients and whereas the said Council and Assembly, called "The Parliament of victoria stand prorogued until Wednesday, the 15th day of February, 1899, and it is expecient further to prorogue the same: Now therefore stand prorogued until Wednesday, the 15th day of February, 1899, until Wednesday, the 15th day of March, 1899.
