PUBLIC HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable Thomas, Baron Brassey, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath;
Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in Part VI. of the Public Service Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1133), I, the Governor of
Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereundermentioned to be observed as Public Holidays at the places respectively specified, viz.:—

TUESDAY, THE 21ST DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Komsey;

Wednesday, the 22nd day of February Instant, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Avoca, * Kyneton, Strathfieldsaye, and Violet Town.*

FRIDAY, THE 24TH DAY OF FEBRUARY INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Winchelsea and Yea;

Tuesday, the 28th day of February Instant, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Bacchus Marsh;

WEDNESDAY, THE IST DAY OF MARCH NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Town of Port Melbourne, the Shires of East Loddon, and Seymour,* and the North and West Ridings of the Shire of Huntly;

THURSDAY, THE 2ND, AND THURSDAY THE 16TH DAYS OF MARCH NEXT, as Public Holidays throughout the Borough of Sale;

SATURDAY, THE 4TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Tungamah;*

Tursday, the 7th day of March next, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Dimboola;*

WEDNESDAY, THE 87H DAY OF MARCH NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Town of Northcote and the Shires of Romsey, Shepparton, and Springfield;

Wednesday, the 8th, Friday, the 17th,* and Wednesday, the 22nd days of March next, as Public Holidays throughout the Shire of Rodney;

THURSDAY, THE OTH DAY OF MARCH NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Northern and Southern Ridings of the Shire of Eltham;

FRIDAY, THE 10TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the North Riding of the Shire of Dimboola;*

Wednesday, the 15th, and Friday, the 17th days of March next, as Public Holidays throughout the Shire of Wannon;

THURSDAY, THE 16TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Cranbourne;

FRIDAY, THE 17TH DAY OF MARCH NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Town of Warrambool,* the Borough of Wangaratta, the Shires of Beechworth (United), Borung, Morwell, Mount Rouse, McIvor, North Overs, Portland, Rosedale,* and Seymour, the North Riding of the Shire of Dunmunkle, and the West Riding of the Shire of Minhamite;

WEDNESDAY, THE 22ND DAY OF MARCH NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Dunmunkle and Traralgon, and the North and West Ridings of the Shire of Ripon;

THURSDAY, THE 23RD DAY OF MARCH NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Rosedale.
