## PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable Thomas, Baron Brassey, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath; Governor and Commander in Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions of the Australasian Federation Enabling Act 1899, I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by this my Proclamation refer and submit to the electors for the Legislative Assembly in Victoria for acceptance or rejection by direct vote the Federal Constitution for Australasia as proposed to be amended in the particulars appearing in the First Schedule to the said Act and as set forth in the Second Schedule thereto, and I direct that

THURSDAY, "HE 27TH DAY OF JULY, 1899.

shall be the date for the said submission to the electors.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the Colony, at Melbourne, this twelfth day of July, in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and ninety-nine, and in the sixty-third year of Her Majesty's reign.
