PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable Thomas, Baron Brassey, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath; Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in Part VI. of the *Public Service Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1133), in Part III. of the *Banks and Currency Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1161), and in the *Public and Bank Holidays Act 1897* (61 Vict. No. 1534), I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays or Bank Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, viz. :—

- TUESDAY, THE 3RD, THURSDAY, THE 5TH, AND WEDNESDAY, THE 25TH DAYS OF OCTOBER INSTANT, as Public Holidays throughout the Shire of Numurkah;
- WEDNESDAY, THE 4TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Echuca;
- WEDNESDAY, THE 4TH, AND WEDNESDAY, THE 11TH DAYS OF OCTOBER INSTANT, as Public Holidays throughout the Shires of Deakin and East Loddon;
- WEDNESDAY, THE 4TH, AND THURSDAY, THE 12TH DAYS OF OCTOBER INSTANT, as Public Holidays throughout the Central and South Ridings of the Shire of Violet Town;
- TUESDAY, THE 10TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT, as a Bank Holiday at Strathmerton, and as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Numurkah;
- WEDNESDAY, THE 11TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Maryborough, the Shires of Corio and Goulburn, and the North and West Ridings of the Shire of Ripon; and as a Bank Holiday at Bridgewater;
- THURSDAY, THE 12TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT, as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Bendigo;
- THURSDAY, THE 12TH, AND WEDNESDAY, THE 18TH DAYS OF OCTOBER INSTANT, as Public Holidays throughout the Borough of Wangaratta;
- THURSDAY, THE 12TH, AND WEDNESDAY, THE 25TH DAYS OF OCTOBER INSTANT, as Public Holidays throughout the Shire of Euroa;
- TUESDAY, THE 17TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Omeo;\*
- WEDNESDAY, THE 18TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Rutherglen and the Shires of Lancefield, Oxley, and Rutherglen;
- WEDNESDAY, THE 18TH, AND THURSDAY, THE 19TH DAYS OF OCTOBER INSTANT, as Public Holidays throughout the Boroughs of Carisbrook and Talbot;
- THURSDAY, THE 19TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Kara Kara, and as a Bank Holiday at Newstead and Talbot;
- WEDNESDAY, THE 25TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Tarnagulla Riding of the Shire of Bet Bet, and the North Riding of the Shire of Violet Town, and as a Public Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, throughout the Borough of Maryborough;
- THURSDAY, THE 2ND DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Sale, and as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Sale;
- FRIDAY, THE 10TH DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Creswick.
