### PUBLIC HOLIDAYS.

#### PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable Thomas, Baron Brassey, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath; Governor and Commander in Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in Part VI. of the Public Service Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1133), I, the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays at the places respectively specified, viz.:—

Wednesday, the 18th day of October instant, throughout the Shires of Dunmunkle and Lowan, and as a Public Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, throughout the Shire of Alberton;

WEDNESDAY, THE 18TH, AND THURSDAY, THE 19TH DAYS OF OCTOBER INSTANT, throughout the Borough of Majorca and the Shire of Avoca;

THURSDAY, THE 19TH DAY OF OOTOBER INSTANT, throughout the Borough of Tarnagulla;

MONDAY, THE 23RD DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT, throughout the Borough of Stawell;

TUESDAY, THE 24TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT, throughout the Shire of Lawloit;

WEDNESDAY, THE 25TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANY, throughout the Shire of Benalla, the North and South Ridings of the Shire of Huntly, the Central and Western Ridings of the Shire of Waranga, and the Barnawartha Riding of the Shire of Yackandandah, and as a Public Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, throughout the South Riding of the Shire of Marong and the North Riding of the Shire of Tullaroop;

Wednesday, the 25th day of October instant, and Friday, the 10th day of November next, throughout the Shire of Creswick;

THURSDAY, THE 26TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT, throughout the Shire of Bacchus Marsh;

WEDNESDAY, THE 1ST DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT, throughout the Shire of McIvor and the North and Central Ridings of the Shire of Violet Town;

WEDNESDAY, THE 1ST, AND THURSDAY, THE 2ND DAYS OF NOVEMBER NEXT, as Public Half-Holidays, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon on each day, throughout the Shire of Omeo;

THURSDAY, THE 2ND DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT, throughout the Shire of Avon;

Wednesday, the 8th day of November next, throughout the Shire of Maldon;

THURSDAY, THE 16TH DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT, throughout the Shire of Warrnambool;

WEDNESDAY, THE 22ND DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT, throughout the Shire of Springfield.
