PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Right Honorable Thomas. Baron Brassey, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath;
Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in Part VI. of the Public Service Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1133), in Part III. of the Banks and Currency Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1164), and in the Public and Bank Holidays Act 1897 (61 Vict. No. 1534), the Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays or Bank Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, viz.:—

WEDNESDAY, THE 1ST DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout that portion of the Shire of Gordon situate on the west side of the Loddon River; and as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Omeo;

Thursday, the 2nd day of November next, as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Clunes and the Shires of Maffra and Rosedale;

Tuesday, the 7th day of November next, as a Public Holiday and Bank Holiday throughout Victoria;

WEDNESDAY, THE STH DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Echuca;

WEDNESDAY, THE 15th DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Glenlyon, Rosedale, and Traralgon; and as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Kyneton;

FRIDAY, THE 17th DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the City of Ballaarat, the Town of Ballaarat East, the Borough of Buninyong, and the Shires of Ballarat, Bungaree, and Buninyong;

THURSDAY, THE 23RD DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Colac and Portland;

THURSDAY, THE 30TH DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Berwick; FRIDAY, THE 8TH DAY OF DECEMBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Portland.
