PUBLIC HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Honorable Sir John Madden, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Lieutenant-Governor of the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in Part VI. of the *Public Service Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1133), I, the Lieutenant-Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays or Public Half-Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, viz.:-

- WEDNESDAY, THE 10TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Western Riding of the Shire of Waranga;
- WEDNESDAY, THE 10TH, AND THURSDAY, THE 11TH DAYS OF OCTOBER INSTANT, as Public Holidays throughout the Shire of East Loddon;
- THURSDAY, THE 11TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Strathfieldsaye;
- THURSDAY, THE 11TH, AND WEDNESDAY, THE 17TH DAYS OF OCTOBER INSTANT, as Public Holidays throughout the Shire of Lawloit;
- WEDNESDAY, THE 17TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of North Ovens, the West Riding of the Shire of Dimboola, and the Barnawartha Riding of the Shire of Yackandandah;
- MONDAY, THE 22ND DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Stawell;
- WEDNESDAY, THE 24TH DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Boroughs of Carisbrook and Talbot, and the Shires of Avoca, Bet Bet, Rodney, and Tullaroop;
- THURSDAY, THE 1ST DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Avon;
- WEDNESDAY, THE 31ST DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Tarnagulla Riding of the Shire of Bet Bet, and the Central and Western Ridings of the Shire of Waranga, and as a Public Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, throughout the North Riding of the Shire of Tullaroop;
- WEDNESDAY, THE 31ST DAY OF OCTOBER INSTANT, AND THURSDAY, THE 1ST DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT, as Public Holidays throughout the Shire of Omeo;
- THURSDAY, THE 1ST DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Maffra;
- THURSDAY, THE 6TH DAY OF DECEMBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Portland.

THE COOPERS BOARD.—ARRANGEMENTS FOR ELECTION.

*At the Executive Council Chamber, Melbourne, the eighth day of October, 1900.*

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts and Regulations made thereunder, the Lieutenant-Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, by an Order dated the 10th day of September, 1900, directed that a Special Board should be appointed to determine the lowest prices or rates of payment which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed in the process, trade, or business of a cooper, and directed that such Special Board should consist of ten members and a chairman: Now therefore His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, pursuant to the provisions of the said Acts and Regulations, doth by this Order appoint Wednesday, the 17th day of October, 1900, to be the day on or before which nominations of candidates for election on the said Special Board shall be received by the returning officer; and Tuesday, the 30th day of October, 1900, to be the day for the election of members of such Special Board.
