PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Honorable Sir John Madden, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Lieutenant-Governor of the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in Part VI. of the Public Service Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1133), in Part III. of the Banks and Currency Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1164), and in the Public and Bank Holidays Act 1897 (61 Vict. No. 1554), I, the Lieutenant-Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays or Bank Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, viz.:—

WEDNESDAY, THE 14TH DAY OF MARCH INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Kyneton;

THURSDAY, THE 15TH DAY OF MARCH INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Maffra;

THURSDAY, THE 15TH, AND FRIDAY, THE 16TH DAYS OF MARCH INSTANT, as Public Holidays throughout the Shire of Omeo*;

FRIDAY, THE 16TH DAY OF MARCH INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Bungaree and Buninyong, and as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Gisborne;

SATURDAY, THE 17TH DAY OF MARCH INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Inglewood and the Shires of Winchelsea and Woorayl*;

Monday, the 19th day of March instant, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of North Ovens and Oxley, as a Public Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, throughout the Borough of Wangaratta and the Shire of Yarrawonga;

Tuesday, the 20th day of March instant, as a Public Holiday throughout the East Riding of the Shire of Melton;

WEDNESDAY, THE 21ST DAY OF MARCH INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Bellarine, * Glenlyon, Huntly, and Violet Town, and the Western Riding of the Shire of Waranga; and as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Avoca;

THURSDAY, THE 22ND DAY OF MARCH INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Maffra, and as a Public Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, throughout the Mortlake Riding of the Shire of Mortlake*;

WEDNESDAY, THE 28TH DAY OF MARCH INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Arapiles, and the South Riding of the Shire of Karkarooc;

THURSDAY, THE 29TH DAY OF MARCH INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Mansfield;*

FRIDAY, THE 6TH DAY OF APRIL NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Towong;

Wednesday, the 11th day of April next, as a Public Holiday throughout the Western Riding of the Shire of Waranga,* and as a Public Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, throughout the North Riding of the Shire of Huntly.*
