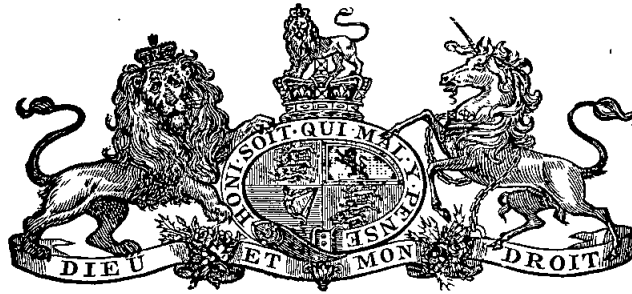

rates which may be paid to any person for wholly or partly preparing or manufacturing, either inside or outside a factory or work-room, the following articles of men's and boys' clothing or wearing apparel, namely, coats (including overcoats and cloaks of every description), vests, trousers, jackets, and knickerbockers—except indiarubber waterproof garments—by the resignation of His Honor Sir Hartley Williams: And whereas the members of the said Special Board have nominated the Reverend Alexander Robert Edgar to be the Chairman thereof: Now therefore His Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, in pursuance of the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts aforesaid, doth by this Order appoint
