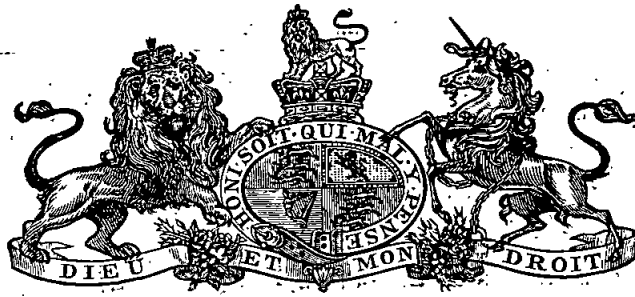

Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE SPECIAL BOARD APPOINTED TO DETERMINE THE LOWEST PRICES OR RATES WHICH MAY BE PAID TO ANY PERSON FOR WHOLLY OR PARTLY PREPARING OR MANUFACTURING, EITHER INSIDE OR OUTSIDE A FACTORY OR WORK-ROOM, BOOTS, SHOES, AND SLIPPERS OF EVERY DESCRIPTION.*

THE Board has fixed the 4th June, 1900, as the date from which the following determination of the Board shall come into force :—

That the maximum number of hours per week for which the lowest wages, prices, or rates fixed by the Board, and set forth in its determination which came into force on the 18th July, 1898, shall be payable to all male employes over the age of sixteen years shall be 48 hours.

That the wages, price, or rate which shall be paid to any male employe over the age of sixteen years who works for any time in excess of the maximum number of hours fixed by the Board shall be Threepence per hour in addition to the wages, price, or rate set forth in the determination of the Board which came into force on the 18th July, 1898.
