PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Honorable Sir John Madden, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Lieutenant-Governor of the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in Part VI. of the *Public Service Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1133), in Part III. of the *Banks and Currency Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1164), and in the *Public and Bank Holidays Act 1897* (61 Vict. No. 1534), I, the Lieutenant-Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays or Bank Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, viz. :—

- TUESDAY, THE 28TH DAY OF AUGUST INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Korong ;
- WEDNESDAY, THE 5TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER NEXT, as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Maldon ;
- WEDNESDAY, THE 5TH, AND WEDNESDAY, THE 12TH, DAYS OF SEPTEMBER NEXT, as Public Holidays throughout the Shire of Kara Kara ;
- WEDNESDAY, THE 5TH, WEDNESDAY, THE 12TH, AND TUESDAY, THE 18TH, DAYS OF SEPTEMBER NEXT, AND WEDNESDAY, THE 3RD DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT, as Public Holidays throughout the Shire of Birchip ;
- WEDNESDAY, THE 5TH, AND WEDNESDAY, THE 12TH, DAYS OF SEPTEMBER NEXT, AND WEDNESDAY, THE 3RD DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT, as Public Holidays throughout the Shire of Donald ;
- WEDNESDAY, THE 5TH, AND TUESDAY, THE 18TH, DAYS OF SEPTEMBER NEXT, as Public Holidays throughout the Shire of Wycheproof ;
- WEDNESDAY, THE 12TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Town of Brighton, and as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Brighton, Donald, and Geelong ;
- WEDNESDAY, THE 12TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, AND WEDNESDAY, THE 3RD DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT, as Public Holidays throughout the Borough of St. Arnaud ;
- WEDNESDAY, THE 12TH, AND FRIDAY, THE 21ST, DAYS OF SEPTEMBER NEXT, as Bank Half-Holidays, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon on each day, at Natimuk ;
- THURSDAY, THE 13TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Bannockburn and Bellarine, and as a Bank Half-Holiday at Wedonga ;
- THURSDAY, THE 13TH, AND FRIDAY, THE 14TH, DAYS OF SEPTEMBER NEXT, as Public Holidays throughout the Shire of Glenelg ;\*
- FRIDAY, THE 14TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER NEXT, as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Rupanyup ;
- FRIDAY, THE 14TH, AND FRIDAY, THE 26TH, DAYS OF SEPTEMBER, AND TUESDAY, THE 2ND DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT, as Public Holidays throughout the Shire of Dunmunkle ;
- TUESDAY, THE 18TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER NEXT, as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Wycheproof ;

WEDNESDAY, THE 19TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, AND WEDNESDAY, THE 17TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT, as Public Holidays throughout the Shire of Shepparton;

THURSDAY, THE 20TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Chiltern and Yackandandah;

THURSDAY, THE 20TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, AND THURSDAY, THE 4TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT, as Public Holidays throughout the Borough of Wangaratta;

WEDNESDAY, THE 26TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the South-West Riding of the Shire of Kerang;

TUESDAY, THE 2ND DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the South and East Ridings of the Shire of Borung;

WEDNESDAY, THE 3RD DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the North-East and South-East Ridings of the Shire of Kerang; and as a Bank Holiday at Dunolly and Tarnagulla;

TUESDAY, THE 9TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT, as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Dimboola and Jeparit;

WEDNESDAY, THE 10TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Maldon;

WEDNESDAY, THE 10TH, AND WEDNESDAY, THE 17TH, DAYS OF OCTOBER NEXT, as Public Holidays throughout the Shire of Goulburn;

WEDNESDAY, THE 17TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Echuca; and as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Tatura.
