PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Honorable Sir John Madden, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Lieutenant-Governor of the Colony of Victoria and its Dependencies, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in Part VI. of the *Public Service Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1133), in Part III. of the *Banks and Currency Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1164), and in the *Public and Bank Holidays Act 1897* (61 Vict. No. 1534), I, the Lieutenant-Governor of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays or Bank Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, viz.:-

WEDNESDAY, THE 26TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the North and South Ridings of the Shire of Charlton and the North Riding of the Shire of Korong, and in the Townships of Korong Vale and Wedderburn within the said Shire of Korong, and as a Public Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, throughout the Borough of Ararat;

FRIDAY, THE 28TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Echuca;*

TUESDAY, THE 2ND DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Numurkah; and as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Cobram;

WEDNESDAY, THE 3RD DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Tarnagulla, the Shire of Kara Kara, the East and Central Ridings of the Shire of Gordon, the North Riding of the Shire of Huntly, the Western Riding of the Shire of Waranga, and the parishes of Laanecoorie, Shelbourne, Tarnagulla, and Woodstock in the South Riding of the Shire of Marong; and as a Bank Half-holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Geelong, Rochester, and Tatura;

THURSDAY, THE 4TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Borung, Karkaroc, and Numurkah, and the North Riding of the Shire of Wimmera; and as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Nathalia;

FRIDAY, THE 5TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the City of Ballarat and the Town of Ballarat East;

TUESDAY, THE 9TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Borung, Numurkah, and Shepparton, and as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Beulah and Numurkah;

WEDNESDAY, 10TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shires of Dunmunkle and Tullaroop, and throughout the Eastern and Central Ridings of the Shire of Waranga;

WEDNESDAY, THE 17TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Boroughs of Rutherglen and Wangaratta, the Shires of Chiltern and Maldon, the United Shire of Beechworth, and the North Riding of the Shire of Euroa;

WEDNESDAY, THE 24TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Borough of Maryborough, the Shires of Numurkah and Shepparton, the Devenish and Mokoan Ridings of the Shire of Benalla, the North Riding of the Shire of Euroa, and the North and Central Ridings of the Shire of Violet Town;

FRIDAY, THE 26TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT, as a Public Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, throughout the Shire of Moorabbin;

MONDAY, THE 28TH DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT, as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Bendigo and Eaglehawk;

FRIDAY, THE 9TH DAY OF NOVEMBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Chiltern.
