PUBLIC AND BANK HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Honorable Sir John Madden, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Vic-toria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia.

In pursuance of the provisions contained in Part VI. of the Public Service Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1133), in Part VII. of the Banks and Currency Act 1899 (54 Vict. No. 1133), in Part VII. of the Banks and Currency Act 1899 (54 Vict. No. 1164), and in the Public and Bank Holidays Act 1897 (61 Vict. No. 1534), I, the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays or Bank Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, viz.:—

WEDNESDAY, THE 14TH DAY OF AUGUST INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Kowree;

THURSDAY, THE 15TH DAY OF AUGUST INSTANT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Bairnsdale, and as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Bairnsdale. Bairnsdale;

WEDNESDAY, THE 23TH DAY OF AUGUST INSTANT, as a Public Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, throughout the Town of Geelong*, and as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Coleraine;

FRIDAY, THE 6TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER NEXT, as a Public Holi-day throughout the Shire of Kowree;

WEDNESDAY, THE 11TH, AND WEDNESDAY, THE 25TH DAYS OF SEPTEMBER NEXT, AND WEDNESDAY, THE 2ND DAY OF OCTOBER NEXT, AS Public Holidays throughout the Shire of Donald;

WEDNESDAY, THE 18TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Tungamah;

THURSDAI, THE 19TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER NEXT, as a Publi Holiday throughout the Boroughs of Rutherglen and Wangaratta, the United Shire of Beechworth, and the Shires of Benalla, Chiltern, Dundas, Mount Rouse, North Ovens, Portland, Tungamah, and Yackandandah, and as a Bank Half-Holiday, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Bright and Wangaratta;

TUSSDAY, THE 24TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER NEXT, as a Public Holiday throughout the Shire of Tungamah;
