PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Honorable Sir John Madden, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in Part VI. of the *Public Service Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1133), I, the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays at the places respectively specified, viz.:-

APPLICATIONS from persons who have served in any Victorian Contingent in South Africa or China, and who are desirous of being employed in the Victorian Foot Police Force will be received at the Police Depot, Victoria Barracks, St. Kilda-road, Melbourne, on Tuesday, 29th October, 1901, at Nine o'clock a.m.
