PUBLIC HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Honorable Sir John Madden, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies, in the Commonwealth of Australia.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in Part VI. of the *Public Service Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1133). I, the Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria, in the Commonwealth of Australia, with the advice of the Executive Council of the said State, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates hereunder mentioned to be observed as Public Holidays at the places respectively specified, viz.:—

- THURSDAY, THE 17TH DAY OF JANUARY INSTANT, throughout the Shire of Heytesbury;
- THURSDAY, THE 17TH,* WEDNESDAY, THE 23RD,* AND TUESDAY, THE 29TH DAYS OF JANUARY INSTANT, AND SATURDAY, THE 2ND* DAY OF FEBRUARY NEXT, throughout the Shire of Tungamah;
- WEDNESDAY, THE 23RD DAY OF JANUARY INSTANT, throughout the Shire of Traralgon;*
- THURSDAY, THE 24TH DAY OF JANUARY INSTANT, throughout the Mortlake Riding of the Shire of Mortlake;
- WEDNESDAY, THE 30TH DAY OF JANUARY INSTANT, throughout the Shire of Borung, and, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, throughout the Town of Geelong;*
- THURSDAY, THE 31ST DAY OF JANUARY INSTANT, throughout the Shire of Wyndham;
- THURSDAY, THE 28TH DAY OF FEBRUARY NEXT, throughout the Shire of Yea.*
