By His Excellency Sir George Sydenham Clarke, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George; Fellow of the Royal Society; Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in Part III. of the Bunks and Currency Act 1830 (54 Vict. No. 1164), and in the Public and Bank Holidays Act 1837 (61 Vict. No. 1534), I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates named hereunder special days to be observed as Bank Half-Holidays, from the hour of Twelvo o'clock noon on each day, at the places respectively mentioned, that is to say:—

WEDNESDAY, THE 3RD DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1902, at Natimuk; WEDNESDAY, THE 10TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1902, at Donald and Geelong;

THURSDAY, THE 11TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1902, at Maffra.
