WEI REAS the number of Victuallers' Licences in the enington Road Licensing District is above the statutory number: And whereas a petition has been received by the Governor of the State of Victoria in Council, in accordance with the provisions of section 27 of the Licensing Act 1890 (34 Vict. No. 1111), from one-fifth of the number of persons whose names for the time being are on the Rolls of Electors for the Electoral Division forming the said Licensing District in force on the day after the publication in the Government Gazette of the number of inhabitants therein, praying that a Poll of the Electors may be ordered to be taken to determine whether or not the number of Victuallers' Licences in such Licensing District shall be decreased: And whereas by section 29 of the said Act it is enacted that the Governor in Council, direct any particular member of the Licensing Court for the Licensing District to take a Poll of the Electors upon a day to be fixed in the said Order in Council: Now therefore His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, dath hereby direct John Keogh, Esq., Police Magistrate, being a member of the Licensing Court for the

aforesaid, to take a Poll of the Electors in the said Licensing District on Thursday, the 30th day of October, 1902, to determine whether or not the number of Victuallers' Licences in the said Licensing District shall be decreased.
