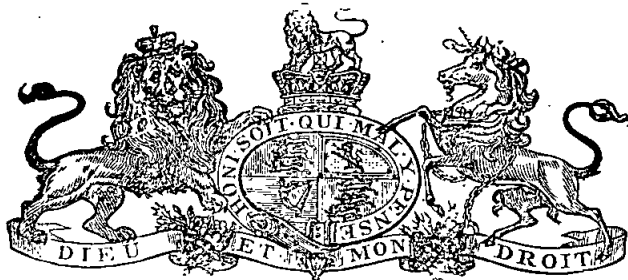

TOWN OF CAULFIELD.

PROPOSED SEVERANCE.

IN pursuance of the provisions of the *Local Government Act 1899* (No. 1112, section 43), the substance and prayer of a petition in accordance with the 10th section of Act 1243 and the 41st section of Act 1112, which has been presented to His Excellency the Governor in Council, are published, viz.:—

The petitioners purport to constitute a majority of the ratepayers in the portion of the Town of Caulfield described in their petition, and they desire that the area so described may be severed from the said Town of Caulfield, and annexed to the Borough of Oakleigh.

Area described in the petition is as follows:—Commencing on the Dandenong-road at the north-west corner of allotment 98 of the parish of Prahran; thence south-easterly by that road to Warrigal-road; thence southerly by Warrigal-road to Warrein road; thence westerly by Warrein-road to the south-west angle of section 84, parish of Prahran; thence northerly by the western boundary of sections 84, 81, 79, 78, 97, and 98 of the said parish to the commencing point.

The petitioners state that the area proposed to be severed forms practically part of the Borough of Oakleigh, its inhabitants transacting their business in Oakleigh, and they consider that it would be greatly to their interests to be annexed to the borough, thereby obtaining direct representation and prompt attention to their requirements.

The petitioners therefore humbly pray that His Excellency in Council may be pleased to sever that portion of the Town of Caulfield above described, and annex same to the Borough of Oakleigh.
