CHANGE OF NAME OF A MUNICIPALITY.

At the Executive Council Chamber, Melbourne, the thirteenth day of May, 1902.

WHEREAS by the Local Government Acts it is enacted that, subject to the provisions of the said Acts, the Governor in Council may from time to time make Orders exercising certain powers therein set forth, amongst others, to alter the name of any municipal district and of the corporation thereof; and that every such Order shall be published in the *Government Gazette*, and shall take effect as from the day of such publication: Now therefore His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, in compliance with the prayer of a petition presented by the municipal council of the Shire of Boroondara, notice of which was duly published in the *Government Gazette* of the 15th day of January, 1902, doth by this present Order alter the name of the said "Shire of Boroondara," and doth direct that the said municipal district shall henceforth be named and designated the

SHIRE OF CAMBERWELL AND BOROONDARA,

and the corporation thereof the President, Councillors, and Ratepayers of the Shire of Camberwell and Boroondara.

And the Honorable John Morrissey, for and on behalf of His Majesty's Commissioner of Public Works for the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
