PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Honorable Sir John Madden, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Lieutenant-Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by Letters Patent passed at Westminster under the Great Seal of the United Kingdom, bearing date the twenty-ninth day of October, One thousand nine hundred, to make provision for the office of Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief in and over the Commonwealth of Australia, and by the said Letters Patent to make permanent provision for the office of Governor in and over the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia aforesaid: And whereas under the Royal Sign Manual and Signet, bearing date at Saint James's the twenty-ninth day of October, One thousand nine hundred, a Commission was issued appointing me to be Lieutenant-Governor of the said State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the said Commonwealth of Australia, with all the powers, rights, privileges, and advantages to the said office belonging or appertaining, and further, in case of the death, incapacity, or removal of the Governor of the said State, or of his departure from the said State, authorizing and requiring me to administer the Government thereof: Now therefore I, Sir John Madden, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia aforesaid, having duly taken and subscribed the necessary oaths before His Honour Thomas a'Beckett, a Judge of the Supreme Court of the said State, and in the presence of the Executive Council of the said State, do hereby proclaim that all the powers and authorities by the said Letters Patent granted to and exercised by the Governor in and over the State of Victoria aforesaid and its Dependencies, became and are now vested in me as Lieutenant-Governor of the said State now residing therein, to be by me exercised and enjoyed in accordance with the terms of the aforesaid Commission bearing date the twenty-ninth day of October, One thousand nine hundred; and in His Majesty's name, I do require and command all officers, civil and military, and all others, the inhabitants of the said State of Victoria, to be obedient, aiding and assisting in the exercise of the functions assigned by the Commission aforesaid to me as the Lieutenant-Governor of the said State of Victoria.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria, at the Government Offices, Melbourne, this twenty-fourth day of November, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and three, and in the third year of His Majesty's reign.
