PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Sir George Sydenham Clarke, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George; Fellow of the Royal Society; Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in Part III. of the *Banks and Currency Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1164), and in the *Public and Bank Holidays Act 1897* (61 Vict. No. 1534), I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates named hereunder special days to be observed as Bank Holidays or Bank Half-Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, that is to say:—

WEDNESDAY, THE 4TH DAY OF MARCH, 1903, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Daylesford, Kerang, Warragul, and Yarrawonga;

WEDNESDAY, THE 11TH DAY OF MARCH, 1903, at Gisborne and Woodend, and from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Daylesford and Foster;

THURSDAY, THE 12TH DAY OF MARCH, 1903, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Maffra;

TUESDAY, THE 17TH DAY OF MARCH, 1903, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Nagambie and Warragul;

WEDNESDAY, THE 18TH DAY OF MARCH, 1903, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Donald, Mornington, and Yarram Yarram.
