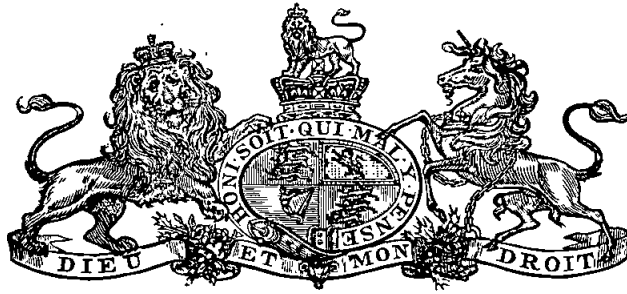

BANK HALF-HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Sir George Sydenham Clarke, Knight
Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint
Michael and Saint George; Fellow of the Royal Society;
Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in
the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in Part III. of the
Banks and Currency Act 1890 (54 Vict. No. 1164), and in
the *Public and Bank Holidays Act 1897* (61 Vict. No. 1534),
I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth
of Australia, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days
and dates named hereunder special days to be observed as
Bank Half-Holidays, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon on
each day, at the places respectively mentioned, that is to say:—

TUESDAY, THE 17TH DAY OF MARCH, 1903, at Beac and
Seymour;

TUESDAY, THE 24TH DAY OF MARCH, 1903, at Lancefield;

WEDNESDAY, THE 25TH DAY OF MARCH, 1903, at Corryong;

FRIDAY, THE 27TH DAY OF MARCH, 1903, at Ballan and
Harrow.
