PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Sir George Sydenham Clarke, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George; Fellow of the Royal Society; Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in Part III. of the *Banks and Currency Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1164), and in the *Public and Bank Holidays Act 1897* (61 Vict. No. 1534), I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates named hereunder special days to be observed as Bank Holidays or Bank Half-Holidays (as the case may be) at the places respectively specified, that is to say:—

WEDNESDAY, THE 28TH DAY OF JANUARY, 1903, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Dookie, Rochester, and Yarram Yarram;

WEDNESDAY, THE 4TH DAY OF FEBRUARY, 1903, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Stawell;

FRIDAY, THE 6TH DAY OF FEBRUARY, 1903, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Creswick;

THURSDAY, THE 19TH DAY OF FEBRUARY, 1903, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon, at Horsham and Sale;

TUESDAY, THE 24TH DAY OF FEBRUARY, 1903, at Bacchus Marsh.
