LICENSING DISTRICTS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Honorable Sir Reginald Arthur James Talbot, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath, Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS by the *Licensing Act 1890*, No. 1111, section 19, it is amongst other things enacted that, for the purposes of the said Act, Victoria should be divided into Licensing Districts, and that each Licensing District should consist of one Division of an Electoral District, as described in *The Constitution Act Amendment Act 1890*, or in any Act amending or repealing the same, or constituting new Electoral Districts or Divisions thereof: And whereas by the *Electoral Districts Boundaries Act 1903* new Electoral Divisions have been constituted: And whereas it is provided by the said Act that, immediately on the coming into force of all the provisions of *The Constitution Act 1903*, the Governor in Council shall proclaim and notify Licensing Districts in accordance with the provisions of the *Licensing Act 1890*, and shall also by such proclamation determine the Electoral Divisions which shall respectively form the Metropolitan, Ballarat, and Sandhurst groups of Licensing Districts: And whereas the coming into full operation of *The Constitution Act 1903* is contingent, among other things, upon the dissolution of the Legislative Assembly occurring next after the coming into force of certain provisions in the said Act: And whereas on the 10th day of May, 1904, I, by proclamation under the provisions of *The Constitution Act 1903*, dissolved the Legislative Assembly, and thereupon all the provisions of *The Constitution Act 1903* came into force: Now I, the Governor of the State of Victoria, by and with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, hereby proclaim and notify that the various Divisions of the Electoral Districts, as described and named in the First Schedule to the *Electoral Districts Boundaries Act 1903*, and set forth in the First Schedule hereto, are henceforth the Licensing Districts within the meaning and for the purposes of the said *Licensing Act 1890*, and shall be known by the said respective names: And, further, I hereby proclaim and determine that the several Electoral Divisions set forth in the Second, Third, and Fourth Schedules hereto shall respectively form the Metropolitan, Ballarat, and Sandhurst groups of Licensing Districts, and such groups so hereby determined shall be substituted for the groups set forth in section 54 of the said *Licensing Act 1890*.
