**W**HEREAS The Parliament of Victoria stands prorogued until Tuesday, the first day of May, 1906: Now I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, do by this my Proclamation further prorogue the said Parliament of Victoria until Tuesday, the fifth day of June, 1906.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this twenty-fifth day of April, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and six, and in the sixth year of His Majesty's reign.
