BANK HALF-HOLIDAYS.

PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Sir Thomas David Gibson Carmichael, Baronet, Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in Part III. of the *Banks and Currency Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1164), and in the *Public and Bank Holidays Act 1897* (61 Vict. No. 1534), I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates named hereunder special days to be observed as Bank Half-Holidays at the places respectively mentioned, that is to say:—

- WEDNESDAY, THE 16TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1908, at Wangaratta;
- THURSDAY, THE 17TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1908, at Hamilton and Sea Lake;
- FRIDAY, THE 18TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1908, at Hamilton and Rupanyup;
- THURSDAY, THE 24TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1908, at Charlton and Yarrowonga;
- FRIDAY, THE 25TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1908, at Horsham and Yarrowonga;
- TUESDAY, THE 29TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1908, at Minyip;
- WEDNESDAY, THE 30TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1908, at Swan Hill;
- TUESDAY, THE 6TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 1908, at Nhill;
- FRIDAY, THE 9TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 1908, at Dimboola.
