Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE POTTERY TRADE BOARD.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Special Board appointed to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed in the process, trade, or business of pottery-making, including the making of tiles and of drain and glazed pipes, and the clay digging in connexion therewith, has made the following determination, namely:—

I. That all previous determinations made by the Board shall be cancelled and anulled from and after the date upon which this determination comes into force and is operative.

II. That the lowest prices or rates to be paid to the following persons or classes of persons employed in the process, trade, or business of pottery-making, including the making of tiles and of drain and glazed pipes, and the clay digging in connexion therewith shall be as follow:—

(b) That the number of female improvers under 21 years of age employed in the process, trade or business of making general pottery, terra-cotta and tiles, shall be three female improvers to every female receiving not less than 20s. per week.

V. That any employé over the age of sixteen years engaged in the process, trade, or business of pottery-making, including the making of tiles and of drain and of glazed pipes, and the clay digging in connexion therewith, who works for any time in excess of the maximum number of hours fixed by this determination shall be paid for such extra time at the rate of time and a quarter.

VI. That, this Determination shall come into force, and be operative on and after the 23rd day of November, 1908.
