PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency the Honorable Sir Reginald Arthur James Talbot, Knight Commander of the Most Honorable Order of the Bath, Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

WHEREAS The Parliament of Victoria stands prorogued until Wednesday, the eighteenth day of March, 1908 : Now I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, do by this my Proclamation further prorogue the said Parliament of Victoria until Tuesday, the twenty-eighth day of April, 1908.

Given under my Hand and the Seal of the State of Victoria aforesaid, at Melbourne, this fourteenth day of March, in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and eight, and in the eighth year of His Majesty's reign.
