ALTERATION OF PROCLAMATION OF A
PROTECTED FOREST.

WHEREAS by section 29 of the *Forests Act 1907*, it is enacted that the Minister of Lands may at any time proclaim any unoccupied Crown land to be a protected forest, and may at any time alter or revoke any such proclamation: And whereas certain unoccupied Crown land in the State of Victoria was proclaimed by me, on the second day of March, One thousand nine hundred and eight, to be a protected forest: Now therefore I, John Emanuel Mackey, Minister of Lands, do hereby alter such proclamation of 2nd March, 1908, by excluding therefrom the portion of unoccupied Crown land described in the Schedule hereto:—
