SHIRE OF RUTHERGLEN RE-SUBDIVIDED.

At the Executive Council Chamber, Melbourne, the
twenty-seventh day of May, 1908.

PRESENT:

His Excellency the Governor of Victoria.

WHEREAS by the *Local Government Act 1903* (3 Edw. VII. No. 1893) it is enacted that the Governor in Council may from time to time make Orders exercising certain powers therein set forth, amongst others, to subdivide or re-subdivide any municipal district into any number of subdivisions not exceeding eight, and to determine and alter, within the limits prescribed by the said Act the number of councillors assigned to any municipality; and that every such Order shall be published in the *Government Gazette*, and shall take effect as from the day of such publication: And whereas a petition purporting to be signed by more than one-fourth of the rate-payers whose names are on the municipal roll of the Shire of Rutherglen has been presented to the Governor in Council, notice of which petition was published in the *Government Gazette* of the 15th day of April, 1908, and no counter petition received: Now therefore His Excellency the Governor of the State of Victoria, with the advice of the Executive Council thereof, doth hereby re-subdivide the said shire into four separate ridings, the names and boundaries of which shall be those severally hereunder set forth and described, and doth hereby further order that a council consisting of twelve members be elected accordingly.

Rutherglen Shire Re-subdivided.

BROWN'S PLAINS RIDING.

Commencing at the intersection of the north boundary of the borough of Rutherglen with a road forming the eastern boundary of allotment 19, section XLI., parish of Carlyle; thence north and north-easterly by the centre of that road to a road forming the north boundary of section XLII. in same parish; thence easterly by the centre line of the last-mentioned road to the north-east angle of section XLIII. in same parish; thence northward by the centre of the parish boundary road to the north-east angle of allotment 2, section XXXII., parish of Carlyle; thence northward and north-westerly by the parish boundary to the Murray River; thence easterly by that river, and southerly by Indigo Creek (being the shire boundary) to the centre of a road opposite the south-east angle of allotment 104, section A, parish of Gooramadda; thence westerly by the centre of the said road (being the shire boundary) to the south-west angle of allotment 4, section F, parish of Gooramadda; thence in a southerly direction along the centre of a road forming a portion of the east boundary of the shire to the south-east angle of

allotment 1824, parish of Chilfern West; thence westerly, south-westerly, westerly, and north-westerly along the centre of a road to the north-east angle of allotment 246 in same parish; thence in a general north of west direction by the centre of the same road to its intersection with a three-chain road near the Lilliput parish eastern boundary; thence in a north-westerly direction by the centre of the last-mentioned road to the boundary of the borough of Rutherglen; thence north and west by that boundary to the starting point.

LILLIPUT RIDING.

Commencing at the north-west angle of allotment 144 of section I., parish of Lilliput; thence eastward by the centre of a road forming the northern boundary of that parish to the boundary of the borough of Rutherglen; thence south, then east, and then north by the last-mentioned boundary to a point in the centre of a three-chain road forming the north-east boundary of section XI.VA., parish of Carlyle; thence south-easterly by the centre of that road to its intersection on its northern side with a road near the eastern boundary of Lilliput parish; thence by the centre of the latter road in a general south of east direction to the north-east angle of allotment 246, parish of Chilfern West; thence along the same road in a south-easterly, easterly, north-easterly, and easterly direction to its intersection with a road forming part of the eastern boundary of the shire; thence along that boundary southerly and then westerly to the south-west angle of allotment 6, parish of Bontherambo; thence northerly along the centre of a road forming (for the greater part of the way) the west boundary of the parish of Lilliput to the starting point.

NORONG RIDING.

Commencing at the north-east angle of allotment 1A, section A, parish of Norong; thence by the centre of a road southward to the shire boundary; thence westward along the centre of a road forming part of the said boundary to the south-west angle of allotment 40, parish of Boorhaman; thence northward along the centre of the shire boundary road to the north-east angle of allotment 9 in the same parish; thence westerly by a line forming the north boundary of allotments 9, 9A, 8B, and 8A in the same parish to the north-west angle of allotment 8A aforesaid; thence northward along the centre of a road to the north-west angle of allotment 6 in the same parish; thence westerly along the centre of a road forming the south boundary of Brimih parish to the Ovens River; thence northward by that river to the Murray River; thence eastward by the latter river and by the north boundary of the parish of Norong to the starting point.

WAHGUNYAH RIDING.

Commencing at the intersection of the north boundary of the borough of Rutherglen with a road east of allotment 19, section XLI., parish of Carlyle; thence north and north-easterly along the centre of that road to its intersection with a road forming the north boundary of section XLII., parish of Carlyle; thence eastward by the centre of the

last-mentioned road to the north-east angle of section XLIII. in the same parish; thence northward by the centre of the parish boundary road to the north-east angle of allotment 2, section XXXII., parish of Carlyle; thence northward and north-westward by the parish boundary to the Murray River; thence westerly and southerly by that river (being the shire boundary) to the southern boundary of Carlyle parish; thence east along the centre of a road forming such boundary to the boundary of Rutherglen borough; thence northward and eastward along the last-mentioned boundary to the starting point.

The shire boundary above referred to is that described in the *Government Gazette* of the 20th April, 1903.

And the Honorable Ewen Hugh Cameron, His Majesty's Commissioner of Public Works for the State of Victoria, shall give the necessary directions herein accordingly.
