VICTORIAN RAILWAYS.

VICTORIAN RAILWAYS COMMISSIONERS.

BY-LAW No. 210.

THE VICTORIAN RAILWAYS COMMISSIONERS, in pursuance of the powers conferred in that behalf under the provisions of the Railways Acts, do hereby make the following By-law, and do hereby repeal so much of the provisions of all previous By-laws as conflicts therewith:—

- (a) The rates specified in class A.P., under the heading of "Mileage rates per ton for Goods," in By-law No. 198, shall be reduced by Three (3) pence per ton in respect of agricultural produce carried any distance from 100 miles to 200 miles inclusive, and by Four (4) pence per ton in respect of agricultural produce carried any distance in excess of 200 miles.
- (b) The additional charge which shall be paid in respect of agricultural produce carried at the risk of the Commissioners shall be Three (3) pence per ton for any distance not exceeding 200 miles, and Four (4) pence per ton for any distance beyond 200 miles.
