

Factories and Shops Acts.

DETERMINATION OF THE GLASSWORKERS BOARD.

IN accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Special Board appointed to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person or persons or classes of persons employed in the process, trade, or business of (a) glass-blowers; (b) glass moulders; (c) a maker of all kinds of glass utensils (except cut-glass utensils), including glass bottles, glass jars, glass jugs, glass globes, tumblers, salt cellars, and vials, has made the following determination, viz. :—

PROPORTION OF IMPROVERS IN GLASS BOTTLE FACTORIES.

(2) That the number of Improvers who may be employed in any factory or work-room, or shop, or place in which the process, trade, or business of (a) Glass-blowers, (b) glass-moulders, (c) a maker of all kinds of glass utensils (except cut-glass utensils), including glass bottles, glass jars, glass jugs, glass globes, tumblers, salt cellars, and vials is carried on shall be—one improver to every six persons or fraction thereof receiving the prices or rates provided in this Determination for adult males or piece-work.

PROPORTION OF IMPROVERS IN FLINT GLASS FACTORIES.

(3) That the number of Improvers who may be employed in any factory or work-room, or shop, or place in which the process, trade, or business of a flint-glass worker is carried on shall be—five improvers to every four persons receiving the prices or rates provided in this Determination for adult males or piece-work.

(6) That any male person over the age of sixteen years engaged in the process, trade, or business of—
(a) Glass Blowers; (b) Glass Moulders; (c) A maker of all kinds of glass utensils (except cut-glass utensils), including glass bottles, glass jars, glass jugs, glass globes, tumblers, salt cellars, and vials, who works for more than 48 hours per week shall be paid for such extra time at the rate of time and a quarter.
