

Factories and Shops Acts.

IN compliance with an application in writing under the provisions of the Factories and Shops Act 1905, and after due inquiry, I, being the responsible Minister for the time being administering the said Act, do hereby suspend the operation of sub-section (1) of section 40 of the said Act in the

FACTORY OR WORK-ROOMS OF THE ROSELLA PRESERVING CO. PTY. LTD., BALMAIN-STREET, RICHMOND,

for a period of eight weeks from the 21st December, 1909, upon the following express conditions, that is to say:—

- 1. That no person or persons shall employ in the said factory or work-rooms more than one hundred females or more than twelve boys under the age of sixteen years for more than forty-eight hours in any one week, and that the said one hundred females and twelve boys under the age of sixteen years shall not be employed for more than fifty-seven hours in any one week, nor for more than three hours beyond the ordinary working hours in any one day, in preparing or manufacturing articles for trade or sale.
- 2. That every boy under the age of sixteen years and every female so employed shall receive not less than Eight shillings per week for each week during which he or she works overtime, and, in addition, each wage-worker shall be paid for such overtime at the rate of time and a half; and each piece-worker shall be paid Threepence per hour for overtime in addition to ordinary carnings by piece-work.
- That every boy under the age of sixteen years and every female shall receive Sixpence tea money each evening he or she works overtime.
- That none of such females or boys shall be so employed for more than forty-eight hours in any one week without their consent.
- That a copy of this Order be kept conspicuously and con-tinually posted in such factory or work-rooms for the information of all concerned.
