Factories and Shops Acts.

## DETERMINATION OF THE CLOTHING BOARD.

In accordance with the provisions of the Factories and Shops Acts, the Special Board appointed to determine the lowest prices or rates which may be paid to any person for wholly or partly preparing or manufacturing, either inside or outside a factory or work-room, the following articles of Men's and Boy's Clothing or Wearing Apparel, namely, Coats (including Overcoats and Cloaks of every description), Vests, Trousers, Jackets, and Knickerbockers, except Indiarubber Waterproof Garments, has made the following Determination, namely:—

(1) In the Determination of the Clothing Board, published in the Government Gazette of the 3rd December, 1908, under the heading Improvers and Apprentices Wages (page 5603).
