PROCLAMATION

By His Excellency Sir Thomas David Gibson Carmichael, Baronet, Knight Commander of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George; Governor of the State of Victoria and its Dependencies in the Commonwealth of Australia, &c., &c., &c.

IN pursuance of the provisions contained in Part III. of the *Banks and Currency Act 1890* (54 Vict. No. 1164), and in the *Public and Bank Holidays Act 1897* (61 Vict. No. 1534), I, the Governor of the State of Victoria in the Commonwealth of Australia, do by this my Proclamation appoint the days and dates named hereunder special days to be observed as Bank Half-Holidays at the places respectively mentioned, that is to say:—

Bank Half-Holidays, from the hour of Twelve o'clock noon:—

MONDAY, THE 15TH DAY OF MARCH, 1909, at Apsley;
WEDNESDAY, THE 17TH DAY OF MARCH, 1909, at Elmhurst, Koo-wee-rup, Kyneton, Morwell, Numurkah, Welshpool, and Yarrawonga;

THURSDAY, THE 18TH DAY OF MARCH, 1909, at Melton;
WEDNESDAY, THE 24TH DAY OF MARCH, 1909, at Birchip.
